

CHC50125 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care - Traineeship

Aspire Performance Training offers **CHC50125 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care** as a Traineeship. Students are required to complete 15 units of competency. All 15 units must be completed, and the individual must have completed a total of at least 280 hours of work in a regulated children's education and care service in Australia as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of units of competency, to attain the full qualification. The total number of hours may be applied collectively across all units of competency that include the requirement for workplace hours.

Entry requirements: To hold a CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care

Where only some units of competency are achieved, a statement of attainment will be issued. This qualification forms part of the CHC Community Services Training Package.

The units of competency that make up this qualification include **12 core units** from the core units listed below plus **3 elective units**.

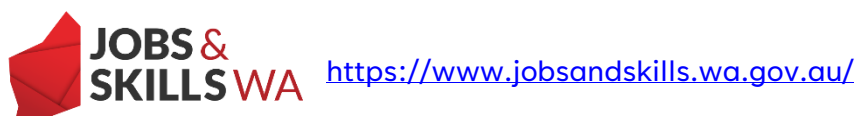
